Day 5 Decatur, Alabama

Day 6 Florence, Alabama

Day 7 Savannah/Shiloh, Tennessee

The jumping off point for Shiloh National Military Park. The park traces the story of Corinth in the Civil War from secession through Reconstruction. It includes two state-of-the-art films on Shiloh and Corinth, plus interactive interpretive exhibits and stunning bronze work.

Day8 Steamboating

Day 9 Paducah, Kentucky

Day 10 Ashport Landing, Tennessee

Day 11 Memphis, Tennessee
