- Day 1 Chattanooga, Tennessee**
Arrive and overnight in a luxury hotel.
- Day 2 Chattanooga, Tennessee**
Welcome to a center of Civil War battle. The Union shelled Chattanooga and, later, took refuge here; it has been besieged, overrun and, finally, reborn as the peaceful, vibrant river town you'll experience. View the serene Walnut Street Bridge, restored to its 1890-era grandeur; stroll the Tennessee Riverwalk, 13 miles in all; or visit the Tennessee Aquarium – including River Journey, one of the world's largest freshwater displays.
- Day 3 Chattanooga, Tennessee**
Embark in Chattanooga.
- Day 4 Steamboating**
This is your time – a full day of blissful cruising – to fully experience all that your elegant ship and friendly crew hold in store. Relax, unwind and melt into the magic of the river.
- Day 5 Decatur, Alabama**
Decatur highlights include the North Alabama Birding Trail, the Carnegie Visual Arts Center, the Princess Theatre Center for the Performing Arts, Riverwalk Marina, Wheeler Wildlife Refuge, two historic districts, and unique shopping and dining experiences.
- Day 6 Florence, Alabama**
Find Alabama's only Frank Lloyd Wright house in Florence, a charming and beautiful city filled with grand Victorian homes and tempting downtown shops. Florence also boasts several museums, parks and historic sites.
- Day 7 Savannah/Shiloh, Tennessee**
The jumping off point for Shiloh National Military Park. The park traces the story of Corinth in the Civil War from secession through Reconstruction. It includes two state-of-the-art films on Shiloh and Corinth, plus interactive interpretive exhibits and stunning bronze work.
- Day 8 Steamboating**
Settle into a rocking chair and just let the scenery glide by. Or join in the fun of numerous onboard activities. Your full day of leisurely steamboating on the Mississippi River sets the tone for an unforgettable vacation.
- Day 9 Paducah, Kentucky**
Known as the city of art, rhythm and rivers, Paducah boasts a lively Lowertown Arts District. The renowned River Heritage Museum, a Save America's Treasures project, and tours via foot, trolley or horse-drawn carriage reveal its charm.
- Day 10 Ashport Landing, Tennessee**
Explore a scenic river landing among the Chickasaw Bluffs, once surrounded by Civil War battles and now a terrific chance to take in the power and grandeur of the Mississippi River.
- Day 11 Memphis, Tennessee**
Explore Memphis, a vibrant American city celebrated for blues, barbecue and the American icon Elvis Presley. Recognized as the birthplace of the blues, Memphis would be a perfect destination to take in some live music.
- Day 12 Steamboating**
The Great Waters of the Mississippi originate in the Rocky Mountains and the Appalachians and roll relentlessly to the Gulf of Mexico. This force of nature is your constant companion during a magical day of uninterrupted cruising.
- Day 13 Vicksburg, Mississippi**
